

Vaccinations Policy

Immunization Requirement for GCU Residents

To ensure the health of the student population living on campus, Grand Canyon University requires students to submit documentation that they received the Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) vaccine or proof of immunity and Meningococcal A vaccine prior to registering for student housing. Immunization Requirement for Programs

Immunization requirements for the University may differ from the immunization requirements for certain programs of student and their associated placement and/or employment opportunities, (e.g., externships, internships, student teaching, clinical, practice, lab opportunities, school district positions). Students may be required to submit immunization documentation to various third-party agencies and are, therefore, responsible for ensuring they meet their respective requirements.

GCU requires students in the following programs to provide immunization records. Students can waive this requirement by following the guidelines published in the Undergraduate/Graduate Field Experience Manuals; however, students who live on campus are not eligible to waive this requirement unless medical waiver is provided and signed by a medical provider.
