The Arizona Board of Regents has contracted with Heartland ECSI "Designee" to provide monitoring for loan recipients. ECSI will send correspondence to all students who receive loans. In its correspondence, ECSI monitors the loan, as you will have to pay it back, if you do not complete the required service obligation. If you do not receive correspondence from ECSI, after completing your first semester, please contact the Arizona Board of Regents at the email address above.

### Section III - Program Agreement

For students enrolled in the Arizona Teacher Student Loan Program at an Eligible Postsecondary Institution:

Grand Canyon University, on behalf of the Arizona Board of Regents is providing to you, the Recipient, an Arizona Teacher Student Loan Program (ATSLP) loan pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 15-1657. For each year, you are a student enrolled in the Arizona Teacher Student Loan Program at Grand Canyon University (the "ATSLP") and continue to satisfy the requirements of A.R.S. § 15-1657 and the terms of this Agreement, you will be eligible to receive an annual ATSLP loan to cover up to the actual cost of tuition, instructional materials as allowed by Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, and fees associated with your program of study.

| I understand and agree that Grand Canyon University and the Arizona Board of Regents have sole discretion to determine whether I have satisfied the requirements of this Agreement, any applicable Board policy, and A.R.S. § 15-1657.   |

| I understand and agree that in exchange for each year that I receive an ATSLP loan from Grand Canyon University, I am obligated to teach for one full school year in an ATSLP Eligible Placement. Recipient an ATSLP loan for one semester, Recipient must teach one semester or equivalent of service at an ATSLP Eligible Placement.) An ATSLP Eligible Placement is the following: a teaching position with an Arizona public school as defined by Ariz. Rev. Stat. Ann. § 15-101 (22). I understand and agree that if I do not fulfill my obligation under this Agreement to teach in an ATSLP Eligible Placement for the required period of time, I will reimburse the Arizona Board of Regents for the proportional amount of the ATSLP loan for tuition, instructional materials, and fees that I received that corresponds to the number of school years I agreed to teach, but did not teach, in an ATSLP Eligible Placement. I understand that A.R.S. § 15-1657 limits eligibility for ATSLP loan funds for undergraduate students to a total of eight (8) semesters (i.e., fall and/or, spring), post baccalaureate student to a total of four (4) semesters (i.e., fall and/or, spring), and for graduate students to a total of four (4) semesters (i.e., fall and/or, spring). I understand that if I have received any ATSLP funds at another postsecondary institution that the award may impact my current ATSLP funds (i.e., received two semesters of graduate funding at postsecondary institution A would only allow for two semesters of graduate funding at postsecondary institution B). I understand and agree that I am required to file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year I participate in the ATSLP. I understand that Grand Canyon University can verify the total amount of the ATSLP loan received by me for each year I participate in the ATSLP. I also understand that I will be informed of this amount annually by the Arizona Board of Regents' designee, prior to and after graduation. Upon completion of the ATSLP and continuing until my teaching obligation is fulfilled, I will create an account with the Arizona Board of Regents' designee and timely submit any required documentation annually by October 1. Each annual report will include employment documentation, employer contact information and my current address/phone information. In addition, I will:

#### Section IV – Repayment Obligation

If I fail to maintain eligibility for the ATSLP, or fail to complete my teaching commitment as set forth in this Agreement, I will:

- 1. Reimburse the Arizona Board of Regents or designee as follows:
  - a. If I do not successfully complete the academic year in good academic standing, or I cease to be enrolled in the ATSLP, I will reimburse the Arizona Board of Regents for the total amount of the ATSLP loan I received for that year.
  - b. If I do not fulfill my obligation under this Agreement to teach in an ATSLP Eligible Placement for the required period of time, I will reimburse the Arizona Board of Regents for the amount of the ATSLP loan for tuition, instructional materials, and fees that I received that corresponds to the number of school years I agreed to teach but did not teach in an ATSLP Eligible Placement.
- 2. Contact the Arizona Board of Regents or designee (See contact info in Section II) to set up a repayment schedule.

- 3. Enter repayment status and begin repayment on the first day of the first calendar month after the earlier of (1) the Arizona Board of Regents or designee determining or, (2) the Arizona Board of Regents or designee being notified that I will be unable or unwilling to fulfill the teaching commitment.
- 4. Make payments to the Arizona Board of Regents or designee according to the schedule established by the Arizona Board of Regents after I enter repayment status.
- 5. Be required to make minimum monthly payments. The repayment schedule will be based on the total amount to be repaid, or as determined by the Arizona Board of Regents. I understand that my repayment schedule will provide for the total loan to be repaid within one to ten (1-10) years, as required by the Arizona Board of Regents.
- 6. Agree that if I fail to repay the loan as stated in this Agreement, that delinquent accounts could be referred to outside collection agencies and could be reported to national credit bureaus. Should it become necessary for the Arizona Board of Regents to retain an attorney or collection agency to secure payment of any amount due, I will be responsible for paying all attorney's fees, court costs, and collection agency charges. Grand Canyon University policy prohibits anyone with delinquent obligations from registering for classes, receiving refunds, obtaining transcripts and diplomas, and use of campus services.

#### Section V - Deferment

\_\_\_\_\_ I may request deferment of repayment in extraordinary circumstances, including the following:

- 1. Becoming temporarily disabled as described in ABOR policy
- 2. Being called to active duty in the armed forces of the United States
- 3. Enrolled, registered, and progressing toward timely degree completion in a full-time master's degree program that would delay required full-time teaching requirement to one year following completion of the master's degree program or two years post- bachelor's degree, whichever is less.
- 4. Other extraordinary circumstances beyond my control, including circumstances identified by the Arizona Board of Regents as qualifying for deferment.
